Iran University of Science and Technology (IUST) proudly welcomes international applicants for admission to its Master's and Ph.D. programs.

Iran University of Science and Technology proudly welcomes international applicants to apply for its Master's and Doctoral programs starting **Monday, May 25, 2026**. Prospective candidates are required to carefully review the following terms and conditions and prepare all necessary documents prior to submitting their applications.

The deadline for submitting applications and uploading required documents for the Master's programs for the Fall 2026–2027 academic term is Friday, June 26, 2026.

In addition, admissions for the Doctoral programs in all fields with available capacity will open in the online system starting Monday, May 25, 2026, and will remain open until further notice.

1- Document Submission

- **Dual citizenship** will result in immediate cancellation of registration.
- All documents (diplomas, transcripts, CV, recommendation letters) must be uploaded in **Persian or English**.
- Applications without complete academic transcripts will be given lower priority for admission. Therefore, applicants are required to submit all documents in full, including their transcripts.

2- Tuition Fees (Per Semester)

- **Master's:** €1,000 (€1,200 for Computer Engineering, English Language Teaching, Management, Economics, and Progress Engineering)
- **Ph.D.:** €1,200
- **Note 1:** The above tuition fees will be calculated and collected in Iranian Rials (IRR).
- **Note 2:** Tuition fees for each semester, expressed in Iranian Rials (IRR), will be determined by the University in accordance with the officially approved rate for that semester.
- Additional costs (housing, meals, insurance) are the student's responsibility.

Cash payments will not be accepted under any circumstances.

3- Grade Point Average (GPA)

- **Master's Applicants:** Minimum GPA of **60/100** (or 14/20) in Bachelor's.
- **Ph.D. Applicants:** Minimum GPA of **60/100** (or 14/20) in Bachelor's and 70/100 (or 16/20) in Master's.

4- Program Duration

- **Master's:** 2–3 years (4–6 semesters; thesis required).
- **Ph.D.:** 3–4 years (6–8 semesters; research-based).

5- Interview

- Applicants may be required to attend an **in-person or online interview** as specified by the department.

6- Student Affairs Approval

- A "**No Objection Certificate**" from the **Student Affairs Organization** is mandatory before final registration.
- To obtain a **SAORG code** and complete the **general eligibility verification**, applicants can proceed through the Student Affairs Registration System at the following address.

7- Initial Admission Processing Fees

The application submission, document review, and issuance of the preliminary acceptance letter are **completely free of charge**; no fees are required for these services.

8- Language Proficiency

- Submission of a certificate of completion for the Persian language course is mandatory for all applicants. In addition, Doctoral applicants are required to submit a certificate of completion for an English language course, while for Master's applicants, this requirement will be subject to the University's discretion
- If the above certificates are not submitted at the time of registration, or at the University's discretion, the applicant will be required to attend a Persian and/or English language course for at least one academic semester prior to the start of classes and successfully complete the course(s).

9- Required Documents for Final Registration

- Original passport.
- Passport-sized photo.
- Authenticated academic diplomas/transcripts (translated to English and verified by the Iranian embassy).

Note:

- After completing the admission process, applicants are required to be present for final registration within the period specified in the initial admission letter. In the event of the applicant's absence, registration cannot be completed through recruitment agencies, legal representatives, or intermediaries.
- All academic certificates and transcripts must be translated into English and authenticated by the Embassy or Consulate of the Islamic Republic of Iran in the applicant's home country, and submitted to Iran University of Science and Technology at the time of registration.

10- Additional Notes

- Admission is **capacity-based**; late applicants may lose priority.
- Submitted documents will be evaluated and scored based on the quality of the applicant's résumé/CV and by specialized committees in the respective field or discipline.
- Applicants who have submitted their admission requests through an agency must, upon acceptance, complete all administrative steps for final registration in person at the Office of the International Students Campus, accompanied by the agency or the agency's legal representative.
- Applicants who have chosen to register without an agency must, upon acceptance, complete all in-person administrative steps personally and without the accompaniment of an agency, translator, or legal representative at the Office of the International Students Campus.
- **If any discrepancies are found between the documents submitted and those uploaded in the admission system at any stage of registration, admission, or during the course of study, the student's registration will be considered null and void, and the individual will be treated in accordance with the University's regulations on violations.**
